Effective Sunday, May 31, Tour 3, all mutual aid resources operating in the NYC 911 System will be suspended.

The FDNY would like to take this opportunity to thank you, our Volunteer and Commercial Ambulance Providers, for being there for our city in this difficult time.

The New York City 911 System incident volume continues to decrease, but the virus isn't going away. The FDNY encourages your organization to take this opportunity to decompress and regroup. The full extent of short-term and long-term effects of coronavirus and the COVID-19 disease it causes, are still unknown.

If necessary the FDNY will reinstitute mutual aid.

Agencies are asked to have a representative return MARS radios on loan to FDNY Headquarters 9 Metrotech Center, Brooklyn on Monday June 1st, 2020 16:00-20:00.
