FEMA Emergency Management Institute: Independent Study (IS) <http://training.fema.gov/is/>

EMI-IS is a FEMA run website that provides online courses free of charge. Courses include NIMS ICS-, Emergency Support Functions, Hazmat and Radiological Incident, Deployment Basics, as well as hundreds of other courses recognized by Homeland Security and FEMA as well as many local agencies. Credits are good as College Credits through Fredrick Community College (FCC). FCC is accredited by the Middle State Association of Colleges.
